Coventry is considerably cheaper than London across the board. From rent and house prices to energy bills and weekly food shops, residents in Coventry enjoy a markedly lower cost of living. It is worth noting that average salaries in London are around 29% higher, which partially offsets the difference in living costs. This is one of the most significant differences between these two cities and is likely to be a deciding factor for many.

The weather in London is a touch more favourable than in Coventry, driven mainly by differences in sunshine. London receives around 160 more hours of sunshine per year. It is not a dramatic contrast, but it may appeal to those who value brighter or drier conditions.

Lifestyle & Location

On balance, London offers a marginally richer lifestyle package. Its advantages include Major Airport Nearby, Strong Rail Links, Large City. That said, the gap is narrow enough that individual priorities could easily swing the verdict the other way.

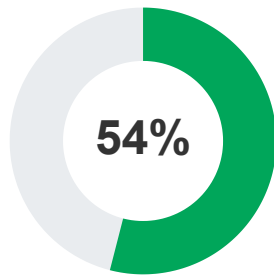

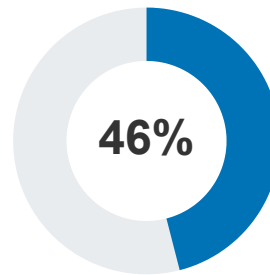
